The Invasion of Canada in 1775, by Edwin Martin Stone, has as an appendix, "The following list of the killed, wounded and taken prisoners of the American troops at Quebec, on the 31st December, 1775, is copied from Ware's Journal, several times before quoted. The asterisks are suffixed to the original, though no signification is given." In a footnote to the above, Stone remarks that "(t)his list of killed, wounded, and taken prisoner is evidently incomplete."
